A Bible Study

Session 3, August 22, 2021

Today we will be continuing to look at some of the Old Testament Scriptures to see how the Holy Spirit is shown to be active, especially in the lives of people chosen by God to lead His people.

Here are the Scriptures that I propose we study today. (I hope you brought your Bible!)

Judges 3:10 – Othniel

Judges 6:34 – Gideon

Judges 11:29 – Jephtha

Judges 13:25; 14:6, 19; 15:4 – Samson

1 Samuel 10:6, 10; 11:6; 16:14; 19:20,23 – Saul

2 Samuel 23:2 - David

Questions for discussion:

- 1 – How did the granting of the Holy Spirit change the trajectory of the affected lives?
- 2 – Think about Old Testament characters that [apparently] did not receive the Holy Spirit. What is implied?
- 3 – Did the presence of the Holy Spirit in a person ensure their holiness?
- 4 – Was the presence of the Spirit permanent?
- 5 – Is there a difference in the meaning of the Holy Spirit being “on” a person or “in” that person?
